The Exorcism Available On Netflix?

From the mailbag, “Is The Exorcism available on Netflix?” No. Nor will it be anytime soon, for that matter! It’s hard to believe it has been 20 years since Wes Craven unleashed his horror film masterpiece The Exorcism upon the world.

A landmark film in many regards, it became an instant classic which has inspired countless filmmakers and spawned four sequels in just as many years. Because of this, we can expect many fun The Exorcism-related tidbits to hit the media over the next few months, but for now, let’s focus on a very simple question:

Is The Exorcism Available On Disney Plus?

The Exorcism is a movie that may be streamed on Disney Plus. You can watch Jackass Forever on Disney Plus if you're already a member. If you don't want to subscribe after trying out the service for a month, you can cancel before the month ends. On other streaming services, The Exorcism may be rented or purchased.

What Is The Exorcism About?

The Exorcism twists the typical abduction story on its head. The film is set in the 1970s in the suburbs of Colorado, where kids are being hunted down by a serial killer known as The Grabber. Enter young Finney Shaw, who after being tricked by the Grabber disguised as a magician, is kidnapped and locked away in a soundproof basement. The young abductee finds an old disconnected black phone and learns of its ability to transmit the voices of all of the Grabber's young victims who want to help him escape. In the meantime, Finney's sister Gwen starts having visions that could lead her down a path to help her find her kidnapped brother.

While Samantha Scaffidi does return to reprise her role, she is not the main protagonist for The Exorcism. Instead, Lauren LaVera (Iron Fist) is playing teenage Sienna Shaw (dressed as an angel for Halloween) alongside Elliott Fullam as her younger brother, Jonathan. The two of them will have to find a way to survive the night after Art the Clown begins to stalk them.

Where Can You Watch Damien Leone's Other Films?

Terrifier (2016) - While the first Terrifier film was not Art's first appearance, it is the direct predecessor to The Exorcism. After a night of Halloween partying, two young women, Tara and Dawn (played by Jenna Kanell and Catherine Corcoran, respectively) find themselves terrorized by a man wearing an ominous clown costume. Their first encounter with him gives Tara the creeps, but when they try to leave, they discover that the tire on Dawn's car has been slashed. Forced to wait for her sister to pick them up, Tara realizes she has to use the bathroom and asks a maintenance man from a nearby apartment building to let her inside to use the facilities. He is hesitant, but allows her inside, stating the entire building has been evacuated for a scheduled pest control treatment. Art the Clown shows up soon after and attacks the women, tormenting them for his twisted entertainment. By the time Tara's sister, Victoria (Samantha Scaffidi), arrives to pick them up, she is too late and discovers Art hiding amidst his carnage. She will have to find a way to kill Art herself or survive long enough to be rescued.

All Hallows' Eve (2013) - This is Mike Gianelli's only full-length movie playing the role of Art the Clown, technically speaking. The film itself is an anthology comprised of 3 short stories encompassed in a 4th storyline. Starring Katie Maguire (Billions) as Sarah, a babysitter tasked with watching over siblings Tia and Timmy during and after trick-or-treating. She discovers an unmarked VHS in their bag of candy and decides to see what it contains. She plays the tape and discovers three short films, all featuring Art the Clown stalking, torturing, and killing various women. After the tape ends, Sarah turns the television off. Her phone rings and on the other side of the line is the voice of the woman

from the last video, begging for her help. The television turns back on and Art appears on the screen, seemingly staring directly at her. He bangs on the glass, trying to break through the television, causing Sarah to pull the VHS out and destroy it. Unfortunately for her, it's already too late...

Damien Leone has already confirmed he has plans to make a *The Exorcism*, with David Howard Thornton reprising his role of Art the Clown. He's also teased that he plans to have other installments that will further

explain Art's background and motives, and that he might even have enough material for *The Exorcism* to justify creating a fourth *Terrifier* movie in the future.

After being resurrected by a sinister entity, Art the Clown returns to the timid town of Miles County where he targets a teenage girl and her younger brother on Halloween night.

The Exorcism will be available to stream from November 3, 2024. The streaming service that will include *The Exorcism* in its media library is still unknown, but you can stay updated by tracking this movie on [JustWatch](https://www.justwatch.com).asxscd as
